## **PROCEDURES FOR USE OF CRICKET NETS** **DURING COVID 19 RESTRICTIONS**

- Each session must have a designated person to ensure these guidelines are adhered to. The designated person will provide hand sanitiser for use before each session. The designated person will also keep a record of who attends which sessions, as should there be a reported case of COVID 19 within the group this will initiate 'track and trace'.
- All training sessions must be pre-booked to avoid gatherings of more than the permitted number of people
- Anyone who has COVID 19 symptoms or is living with someone who does is not allowed to attend
- Each player should arrive already changed as changing rooms are not available at the moment
- Sharing of equipment should be avoided wherever possible. If essential equipment needs to be shared then this is sanitised in between each use.
- The current required social distancing guideline should be maintained at all times unless with someone from your own household
- Each player should use just one ball and not use saliva or sweat to polish it
- The clubhouse must remain closed except for the signposted toilet facilities and first aid should it be required
- Please bring your own drinks as the clubhouse is only open for toilets and first aid
- Each person should bring their own hand sanitiser and sanitise their hands before and after using the available facilities should the need arise
- All 'touch surfaces' within the clubhouse are regularly sanitised. The designated person will clean the touch surfaces at the beginning and end of each session
